



## **SOUTHERN COLORADO PAINT HORSE CLUB**

### **STALLION SERVICE AUCTION SCPHC BREEDERS FUTURITY RULES**

1. Stallion nominations for current stud fee sales will close December 31<sup>st</sup> of Breeding Year. All sales are on a first come, first served basis. Final sales of stallion fees are due on or before December 31<sup>st</sup> when sale will close for the current year. (80% of the proceeds will be allocated between the colts and the fillies based on the total number of entries. Added money if appropriated will be split evenly between the 4 classes.)
2. Checks are to be made payable to SCPHC and sent to the acting Futurity chairman. There will be a \$50 fee assessed for any insufficient check.
3. All sales must be made for 50% of the advertised stud fee or \$200, whichever is greater, plus \$50 handling fee, and will have a live foal guarantee, one year return. The Futurity Conditions are binding upon the owner and /or lessee and their respective successors and assigns. Other terms and conditions of the breeding is the subject of the stallion owners breeding contract.
4. Stallions that stud fees are advertised as Privet Treaty will have a minimum purchase price of \$300.00 + the \$50 office charge.
5. All guarantees are between the stallion owner, lessee, and the purchaser. The stallion owner must declare at the time of the sale any additional fees (i.e. mare care, vet fees, method of breeding, shipping fees, and offer a rebred, etc) that the mare owner will be responsible for.
6. The mare owner who purchases the stud fee and the stallion owner who donated his/her stud fee will each receive one nomination for the futurity. The entry must have one parent that is APHA registered. Solid Paint Bred foals will be allowed to show in their respective class. All entries must meet the dead lines for Mare Owners and Stallion Owners and provide a photocopy of the entry's registration papers if available or photocopy of the registration application.
7. The horse designated for the nomination must be sired by the purchased/donated stallion.
8. If a stallion should die or become unfit to breed, the mare owner who purchased the breeding has the following options:
  - a. Refund of the purchased service price.
  - b. Select a replacement stallion with the approval of the futurity committee and the stallion owner. The replacement stallion owner will receive a slot for the following year's futurity. The replacement stallion owner must abide by all the futurity rules.

9. The stallion owner has the option of buying the stud fee at one-half (50%) of the advertised fee or \$200, whichever is greater, plus a \$50 handling fee if the stallion does not sell. This will make the stallion eligible for current year futurity and give the stallion owner one nomination to the futurity as described in Paragraph 4 (i.e. one nomination for donation, one for purchase).
10. All weanling classes will be split into Junior and Senior Divisions with the split made as follows: Total entries will be divided equally into groups based on age. If an uneven number of foals are entered, a median foal date (half way between the youngest and oldest entry) will be computed and the middle age foal will be placed in the early class if it is older than the median date or in the late class if it is younger than the median date. If the foal should fall on the median date it will be placed in the late class.
11. Weanling colts gelded before the futurity will remain eligible and will be shown with the weanling colts.
12. All nominators and exhibitors must be or become current members of SCPHC.
13. Points: weanlings competing in the Futurity placing in the top six will earn one point for each horse placing below them plus one point not to exceed six for the first place horse, five for the second place horse, etc.
14. Money will be paid on the average placing only. Ties will be broken by tiebreaker judge (determined before the start of the classes.)

**Prize money will be paid to the owner listed on registration papers.**

**Payment will be made by check to owner within 30 days of the futurity.**

15. There will be no substitutions, or refunds of entry fees under any circumstances.
16. No premiums, single or combined over \$600.00 will be issued without owners Security number on file for the IRS 1099 filing.
